

## Home Care Instructions For 7-10 Days After Cosmetic Tattooing

Please read the following instructions carefully!

\*Brows heal in three stages: Too dark - Too light - Just right. This takes one month to happen. Please avoid any friction to the area.

All cosmetic tattooing is a process and requires additional appointments. Final results are sometimes not determined until the follow-up visit is complete.

There is no pain following your treatment, only a slight tenderness, tightness and possible redness around the treated area. Immediately after and for the next 24-hours continue to wipe the eyebrows with a damp cloth tip. It'll keep a clear fluid, (this is normal). Wipe them to remove the fluid otherwise a crusting or scab will build up which is not what we want. You may also experience a white Halo form in the area, this is from the anaesthetic that was used; it will disappear in an hour or so. You'll need to apply suggested lotion/cream to the treated area sparingly three times daily for 7 days. Use a smear only, for approximately three times a day for 7 days. Must be kept moist for successful healing, without scabbing. Colors will appear brighter and more sharply defined immediately after the procedure. Colors will lighten and soften in 3 to 10 days. Often clients think they have "lost" their color as it has lightened. Wait 4 weeks and then judge the result. This is the reason your adjustments (perfection visit) have to wait to be done after 4 weeks.

Do not touch the healing pigmented area with your fingers. They have bacteria on them and could create an infection, always use a clean cotton tip.

- The procedure may have some sort of peeling/flaking on or around the third day, this is completely normal! DO NOT PICK picking will result in scarring and/or loss of color
- Do not get the area wet for 7 days
- No soap or cleansers on a treated area for 7 days
- No topical makeup on treated area for 7 day, this included powders and pencils
- Avoid products containing aloe vera or chemicals during the healing period
- If you experience excessive itching or swelling, any blistering or other complications post-procedure, stop using your Aftercare product and call your technician immediately. You may be allergic to your Aftercare product
- If you have excessive redness, swelling or elevated temperature contact your physician and your technician as the area maybe infected



Follow-up appointments should be scheduled between 4 to 6 weeks after the initial procedure

## General Looking After Your Micropigmentation /Cosmetic Tattoo

- ★ Apply sunscreen over Cosmetic tattoo and wear sunglasses. Exposure to the sun over time can cause feeding and color change
- ★ Cover the tattoo with Vaseline, when going swimming and salt or chlorified water to avoid bleaching effect.
- ★ Any chemicals of any kind could interfere with the bonding process.
- ★ Any glycolic acid peels must be kept completely away from the area as it seems to lighten the color with constant and continuous use.

You cannot donate blood for six months following any Cosmetic tattoo procedure; this is a worldwide health regulation.
